Date Adopted: September 1, 2010

All members of the AFP NY, Hudson-Mohawk Board of Directors are expected to:

- Be an AFP member in good standing
- Attend the board orientation/planning meeting
- Attend all board of directors meetings
- If in a leadership role, prepare a written report for all board and executive committee meetings and attend the executive committee meetings as needed
- Commit themselves to the success of the chapter, focusing on membership, education and revenue generation opportunities
- Uphold their fiduciary responsibilities
- Actively identify and solicit donors and sponsors for AFP/NY, Hudson-Mohawk Chapter
- Disclose conflicts of interest and comply with the chapter's conflicts policy

In their roles as ambassadors for the chapter, all members of the AFP NY, Hudson-Mohawk Board of Directors will:

- Participate in chapter activities and monthly events
- Welcome event attendees and make sure new members and attendees are connected
- Be open to opportunities to mentor new chapter members and new professionals
- Communicate with the chapter membership as appropriate
- Be accessible for questions and concerns regarding the chapter and route inquiries to the appropriate volunteer leader or staff person

As leaders within the fundraising profession and AFP, all members of the AFP NY, Hudson-Mohawk Chapter Board of Directors will:

- Make a personal financial commitment to the AFP Foundation Every Member Campaign (EMC) and encourage other chapter members to make a commitment
- Consider an additional financial gift to the chapter's leadership campaign
- Consider pursuing CFRE credentialing if not already held
- Share their enthusiasm for the organization and ask for investment of time and dollars from their peers
